

Be friendly and respect your fellow athletes

Be a good sport, encourage your fellow athletes

Club uniform must be worn at all times when competing

Parents & Guardians

Show respect to coaches, officials, athletes

Respect the rights, rules and instructions of the club officials

Never ridicule or yell at an athlete

Never use violence, threats or abuse in any form

Parents/Guardians are asked to be actively involved in the running of nightly events

Demonstrate appropriate social behavior

Be supportive to athletes and other parents

There must be a parent/guardian to accompany all children during the

Parents/Guardians are not permitted to drop off children unaccompanied

The club is not responsible for athletes who leave the oval on club night competition.

Penalties for breaches of Code of Behaviour

Athletes and parents found to have brought the sport of athletics in disrepute and fail to follow the club Code of Behavior could mean disciplinary action decided by the club executive. Penalties that are imposed are to be appropriate to the seriousness of the breach.
